March 2—That in the opinion of the Senate, it is desirable that if any change is made in the boundaries of the Provinces of Ontario, Quebec and Manitoba, or any of them, the interests of the Maritime Provinces should be safeguarded by the reservation to the Dominion, for the benefit of the Maritime Provinces, of at least part of the mineral rights in the Territories added to the first-named Provinces.
