April 3, 1930. Mrs. Murray called today and asked my opinion as to the advisability of a campaign to raise money for a large concert hall. I discouraged her by saying that I was sure that at the present time such a campaign would not receive the support of the men on the Board of Governors of McGill University because a campaign now of that magnitude would "muddy the street". She seemed very interested in all I had to tell her of McGill's problems and I am sure she is a friend of the University. AWC: DM
