

## Proposed New Tax Explained to Directors of Motor League.

The president of the Toronto Automobile Trade Association, R. Home Smith, was present on behalf of the association and presented the league with a cheque for \$1000 as a donation from the proceeds of the Toronto Motor Show, the money to be used by the league in furthering its work.

R. Home Smith in a letter to the directors stated that the Toronto Motor Show, which is being held at the east end of the Lake Shore road to Dundas street, will be a big success and would shortly be opened for traffic. He requested the league to place signs, and the slogan "Dangerr," as possible.
