BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE I.

Any person joining this Society who came to Initiation. the country prior to 1st January, 1860, shall be allowed to enroll his name free of admission. All after that date shall pay a fee of \$5.00, except those who already belong to the British Columbia Pioneer Society of Victoria, whose entrance fee shall be \$2.50. Each member as he joins the Society will be required to sign the Constitution and By-Laws, with his name in full, together with his place of birth, residence, occupation, declaration of good health, and to the best of his belief, the date of his arrival within the limits of British Columbia.

ARTICLE II.

Every applicant for membership shall be proposed and seconded by members of the Proposal for Society, at a regular monthly meeting thereof, who shall present to the Secretary his full name, place of residence, occupation, condition of health, and the date of his arrival in the country; all of which the Secretary shall record in a book of registry to be provided for that purpose, and he shall also post the name of

Membership.
