The persons alluded to, pretend to appeal to the spirit of Winggism, while they endeavour to put in motion all the turious and dark passions of the human mind. The spirit of Whiggism, is generous, humane, beneficent and just. These men inculcate revenge, ernelty, perfecution, and perfidy. The spirit of Whiggism cherishes legal liberty, holds the rights of every individual facred, condemns or punishes no man without regular trial, and conviction of some crime declared by antecedent laws, reprobates equally the punishment of the citizen by arbitrary acts of legislature, as by the lawless combinations of unauthorised individuals :- While these men are advocates for expelling a large number of their fellow-cirizens unheard, untried; or if they cannot effect this, are for disfranchifing them, in the face of the constitution, without the judgment of their peers, and contrary to the law of the land.

The 13th article of the constitution declares, that no member of this state shall be disfranchised or defrauded of any of the rights or privileges facred to the subjects of this state by the constitution, unless by the law of the land or the judgment of his peers." If we enquire what is meant by the law of the land, the best commentators will tell us, that it means due process of law, that is, by indicament or presentment of good and lawful men, and trial and conviction in consequence.

It it is true, that in England, on extraordinary oc-

cations, attainders for high treason by act of parliament have been practiced, but many of the ablest advocates for civil liberty have condemned this practice, and it has commonly been exercised with great caution upon

individuals only by name, never against general descriptions
