passed into the skies, said: "God will take HERBIE care of them and not let them die," and BELLAMY requested that one should be sold each year, the proceeds to fill his box when he could no longer write for it. The second year after Herbie's death, over two hundred and eighty dollars was raised from Herbie's legacy and the Mission Band mite boxes.

We wonder at his business methods, at his capacity for planning and devising means for the carrying out of these plans, but we must come to the one conclusion he was taught of God, and his will being wholly lost in the will of the Father, God honored the instrument by making him the channel through which His glory should be advanced. For the Lord taketh the weak things of this world to confound the things that are mighty. The work
