Entries for Two Betless Races to Be Run at Blue Bonnets Track.

Montreal, Sept. 13.—Out of an original nomination of twelve horses for the Quebec King's Plate race, to be run at Blue Bonnets tomorrow, as the feature of the Red Cross betless benefit, to be given by the Montreal Jockey Club, nine or ten will likely face the starter. Of these, there are only three three-year-olds likely to go, the remaining number being four five-year-olds.

There is no outstanding favorite. All of them have done all that has been asked of them, and are now at the top of their form.

Two of the possible starters, Dix Rogers and Javato, are considered for winning. Javato won the Provincial Nursery two years ago and has not started since. For that victory and two previous ones he will have to carry a penalty of five pounds. Two of her races were won on the Canadian circuit. Dix Rogers, which won at Mount Royal as a three-year-old, picks up a penalty of three pounds. The others carry scale weights.

The Provincial Nursery will have four starters out of original nomination of five. These two-year-olds will carry scale weights. They, like the platers, are in good condition for what promises to be the most open contest ever run for in this stake.
