WEEKLY REVIEW.

The principal features of the market for the week closing were lower prices for peas, butter and veal, and higher prices for dressed hogs. The bulk of the receipts of grain were oats and wheat. Quite a few peas came forward, but or barley offered, and prices for corn are unchanged.

In provisions, butter and eggs made up the greater part of the deliveries. Veal and beef were plentiful, and dressed hogs scarcer. Chickens were the only dressed birds that made any showing; they sold well, and odd turkeys came in.

A few lots of unwashed wool offered and sold at 9c to 12c. Hides, skins and tallow were active at unchanged values.

Vegetables were steady: cabbage, carrots, potatoes, onions and peas, being the only lines offered. Prices unchanged.

Maple syrup sold at \$1 per gallon; supply light.

Hay sold at much the same prices as last week, \$5.50 to \$6.50. Young pigs were \$2.50 to \$3.50 per pair.

Lave hogs were sold at \$4.40 to \$4.50 f.o.b., the cars here.

Red clover seed at \$3 to \$3.25, according to sample. No other seeds offered.

A good many live hens, of fancy breeds, of fair to strictly pure stock offered. The prices ranged from 50c to \$1.50 per pair.
