

AMERICAN COLONY IS ANXIOUS TO GET OUT OF RUSSIAN CAPITAL

Embassy Has Requested Train for Departure.

KERENSKY CONTROL GONE

Traveller Reaching Stockholm Says Premier Will Never Regain Power.

LONDON, Nov. 19.—The American embassy at Petrograd, according to a Reuter dispatch, has requested that a train be provided to convey 200 members of the American colony in Petrograd to Harbin.

LENINE IS ON TOP.
LONDON, Nov. 19.—The Berlin Tagblatt declares that Premier Kerensky and Nikolai Lenin, leader of the Bolshevik revolution, are in Petrograd, having effected a compromise essentially favorable to Lenin, the Exchange Telegraph correspondent at Copenhagen reports.

Police Magistrate Will Turn Over All Arrested Under M. S. A. to Military.

SHIP MEN TO FRANCE?

This Seems Likely Procedure for Those Who Figured On Life in Jail Instead of Army.

The impression that the jails and the prisons will be filled with men who have been refused to enter an exemption claim of report for service sheet is being spread by the military authorities, who say they will hand over every man coming before him to the military authorities, providing they are acceptable.

The order-in-council governing procedure with respect to the disposition of men arrested under the act as deserters states that the magistrate can hand the man over to the military authorities.

Magistrate Graydon takes a definite stand in this regard and today announced his decision of turning over all men brought before him to the military authorities to deal with. This plan will be in all cases where the military authorities agree to accept the man.

In the case of the man who is not acceptable to the military authorities, the magistrate will dispose of under a writ of habeas corpus.

It is many men who have imagined they were going to get a term in jail instead of a course in military training will be disappointed. The military authorities will be practically impossible to escape. The opinion of the magistrate is that nothing would be gained by placing the men in jail when they are needed in the army.

When a man is arrested as a deserter and found a 2, and the military authorities agree to deal with his case, the magistrate is not to get the man.

75 CENT ADVANCE RECORDED IN HOGS
