



HOUSE OF WINDSOR **NEW DESIGNATION**

The attendance of the council was cluded Premier Lloyd, George, Foreign Secretary Balfour and other members of the cabinet, the Archbishop of Canterbury, former Premier Asquith and all members of the colonial governments who are now in London. The privy council unanimously endorsed King George's announcement, and the proclamation putting it into effect was the largest since the coronation. It in-

Royal Proclamation.

The King's proclamation changing the name of his house to that of Windsor says:

"We, out of our royal will and authority, do hereby declare and announce that as from the date of our royal proclamation our house and family shall be styled and known as the louse and family of Windsor, and that all descendants in the male line of our grandmother, Queen Victoria, who are subjects of these realms, other than the female descendants who may marry or have married, shall bear the said name of Windsor.

"And we do hereby declare and announce that we for ourselves and for and on behalf of our descendants and all other descendants of our grandmother, Queen Victoria, who are subjects of these realms, relinquish and enjoin the discontinuance of the use of degrees, styles, dignities, titles and honors of the Dukes and Duchesses of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha and all other German degrees, styles, dignities, titles and honors and the appellation to us or to them herefore belonging or appertaining."
