leaving a balance of \$241.01 on hand, was submitted, with report thereon of the Audit Committee.

"That the Statement and Audit report be adopted, and printed in the Association Report."—Carried.

The following letter was then read:

Captain HARTT stated that had the meeting been a larger one, it was his intention to have brought up for consideration how far it would be desirable to amend the Constitution in the matter of membership by doing away with the present affiliated system, and making all competitors alike full members of the Association at a smaller charge than full members now pay; and to consider the question of lumping the entrance and membership fees, so that one definite amount would cover all expenses in these respects.
