

We fillynn, in his report, cites several examples, one of the most astonishing of which was the case of a city employe, who fourteen years ago borrowed \$15 and still owes it to the money lender, although he has paid him out in interest the sum of \$376.32.

Another man, three years ago, borrowed \$10, still owes it, although \$89.64 of his wages have gone into the pockets of the money lender.

The repert says that in every case the difficulty began with a loan of \$10, on which a charge of \$2.18 a month was made untill about a year ago when the Supervisor of Small Loans fixed the maximum charge at \$1.50 a month.

One employe has paid these rates of interest on a \$10 loan every month for the last eight years and still owes the \$10. In almost every instance the initial loan was obtained to meet some emergency, usually sickness, either of the employe or of a member of his family.
