SYNOD PLEDGES HELP FOR JEWISH WELL-BEING
The following resolutions were passed at the Inter-Diocesan Jewish Missionary Conference assembled at the Synod Hall in Montreal:
"Moved by His Lordship the Bishop of Toronto, seconded by the Rev. F. H. Brewin, and carried unanimously: That this Inter-Diocesan Jewish Missionary Conference assembled desires to express its sincere sympathy with the Jewish race wherever the world over they have been or are the objects of hatred and persecution. This conference strongly deprecates both deliberate and accidental violence and outbreaks of anti-Semitic character, and wishes to assure our fellow subjects, the Jews of the Dominion, of their hearty abhorrence of all such, wherever found. The members of this conference further pledge themselves to pray for the wellbeing and peace of the Jewish people, and to do all in their power to bring about a change in the hostile attitude wherever it is possible for any to do so."

Seeds and the Eastern Trust Company, executors.
In the matter of the estate of Isaac W. H. Blatchford were sworn in as executors, real estate \$200; personal, \$1,300. J. B. M. Baxter, K. C., proctor.

London, Oct. 29.—The Canadian Pacific Railway Company's ocean services will start a new service between Southampton and Canada on November 15, with the steamer Scotian. This will give them regular services from Liverpool, London, Bristol, Glasgow, Southampton and Antwerp.
