

DEATHS

Rev. Joseph Ouellette.

Moncton, March 9.—Father Joseph Ouellette, one of the best known priests in the eastern section of New Brunswick, died today at his home in St. Mary's, Kent county, at the age of 84 years. He was the oldest priest in the diocese. Father Ouellette retired from active work in the priesthood in 1919, after having been pastor at St. Mary's for 43 years.

He was born at Frenchville, Me., April 10, 1840, and was ordained by the late Bishop Sweeney June 29, 1868. With the exception of two years spent at the Cathedral, Father Ouellette spent the whole of his long ministry at St. Mary's, Kent, for some years also having charge of St. Paul, St. Norbert and Adamsville, churches at all of these places being built under his jurisdiction.

Child of Thomas E. Mantle.

The friends of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas E. Mantle will regret to learn of the death of their infant son, LeRoy John, which occurred in this city on Saturday. The child was four months old and had been in ill health for weeks. The funeral took place at 2:30 this afternoon and was private.

The death of Thomas Hourahan occurred yesterday at his home, 196 Paradise Row, and will be heard of with regret. Mr. Hourahan was a well known and highly respected citizen. He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Katherine Lawlor, of this city. The funeral will take place on Tuesday morning from his residence to Holy Trinity church for high mass of requiem.

St. John the Baptist Society marched in the procession following the hearse and the Longshoremen's Association also attended the funeral in a body. The funeral was very largely attended. 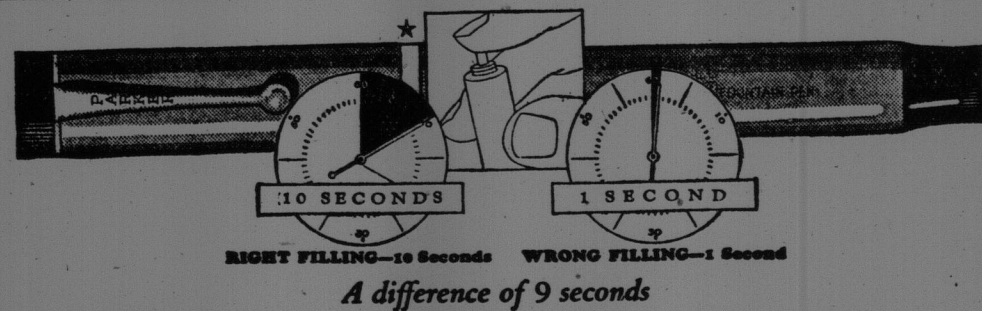
PAYS A TRIBUTE TO DEAD NURSE

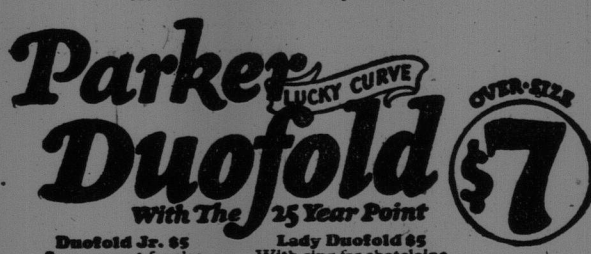

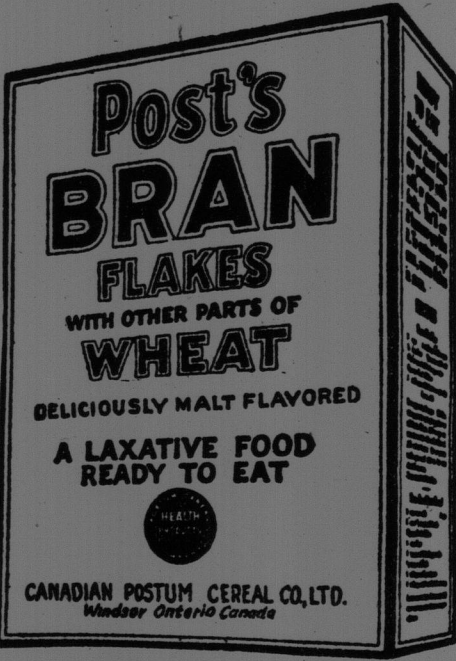

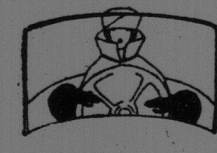
