Q.120 A.120	You are the soldier who was on guard at No.1 A.A.Post, New Wellington Barracks, Halifax, Nova Scotia, at approximately 1700 hours on the 5th, of March 1942? Yes, Sir.
0.121 A.121	Twll the Court just what happened, in your own words! I was warned by Sergeant Wensley for duty at No.1 A.A.Post and I went to the Post and relieved the man on duty there. After he left I placed my rifle and steel helmet on the parapet and started to clean up around the gun. There were some empty magazinex cases and papers on the floor of the post. I threw one magazine up on the top of the Post. It struck the helmet and the helmet rolled down.
Q.122 A.122	Where did the helmet roll? Down the hill.
Q.123 A.123	In what direction? Towards the fence.
Q.124 A.124	Describe the A.A.Post- how high is it? About four and a half feet high from the boards on the floor of the Post to the top of the ground. The sandbags rise above the ground. In the middle is an A.A. Tripod and gun.
Q.125 A.125	How steep is the slope? Pretty steep in front.
Q.126 A.126	When you say front, what direction do you mean? Towards the fence.
Q.126 A.126	How far did the helmet roll? About half way to the fence.
Q.127 A.127	How far is it from the Post to the fence? About thirty five yards.
Q.128 A.128	In yards, how far did the helmet roll? It would be about sixteen yards.
Q.129 A.129	How long had you been on guard? About a minute and a half.
Q.130 A.130	Did you see Mr. Jones running towards the Post? No. Sir. I was about five yards from the Post when I first saw Mr. Jones near the Post.
Q.131 A.131	What was said by Mr.Jones? He was very mad; he placed me under open arrest.
Q.132 A.132	Did you see any soldiers near the fence? Yes, sir.
Q.133 A.133	Did you see any other persons near the fence? Wo,Sir.
Q.134 A.134	What were your instructions regarding your duty at the Post? To watch for hostile aircraft.
Q.135 A.135	How far is it between No.1 and No.2 A.A.Fostsv Thirty to forty yards.
