Transfer of Students.

Undergraduates of other Law Schools may be admitted to an *ad cundem* standing in this School if, on examination, they shall be found qualified. Any person duly matriculated may, at the end of the first year, (though he has not attended the lectures of the School) matriculate as a student of the second year on passing the same examination as is provided for students at the close of the first year, and the same provision shall apply to the third year.
