Surely it is time that we should bestir ourselves and adopt some more stringent measures and adhere to them, when we see the way that political parties bid for the Romish vote, by pardoning red handed murderers and otherwise truckling to that party and thus ignoring all their former professions for the sake of place and power.

Your Grand Secretary is gratified in being able to inform you, that from an extended correspondence and other sources of information, he is able to report, that our beloved Association is progressing, not only in the Motherland and other portions of the Empire, but also in the neighboring Republic.
