CORRESPONDENCE

Aldershot Camp, N. S., 7th July, 1916.

To the Editor: Sir:—Will you be good enough to publish the following for the benefit of all concerned: "The troops at Aldershot are not allowed to cross the Boundary Line of Kings County."

Warning is hereby given to Automobile owners, drivers and livermen to the effect that they must not take any soldiers belonging to this Camp across the Boundary line, unless the man is in possession of a pass signed by his Commanding Officer, and bearing the stamp of the unit to which he belongs.

Any person in the United Kingdom or elsewhere by any means whatsoever. (1)—Procures or persuades any soldier to desert, or attempt to procure or persuade any soldier to desert, or (2)—Knowing that a soldier is about to desert, aids or assists him in deserting; or (3)—Knowing any soldier to be a deserter conceals such soldier, or aids him or assists him in concealing himself, or aids or assists in his rescue.
