On motion of the Honourable Sir Mackenzie Bowell, seconded by the Honourable Mr. Scott, it was

Resolved, That a Message be sent to the House of Commons by one of the Masters in Chancery, informing that House that the Senate has appointed the Honourable Messieurs Almon, Baker, Bernier, Boucherville, de, Drummond, Gowan, C.M.G., Landry, Masson, MacInnes (Burlington), McClelan, Mowat (Sir Oliver), K.C.M.G., Poirier, Power, Ross, Scott, and Wark, a Committee to assist His Honour the Speaker in the direction of the Library of Parliament, so far as the interests of this House are concerned, and to act on behalf of this House as members of a Joint Committee of both Houses on the Library.
