An Act to authorise the Municipal Council of the Town of Chatham to dispose of the Land now set apart for a Cemetery in the said Town.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Town of Chatham have re- Presmble. presented that the ground set apart in the said Town by the Crown for the purposes of a public Cemetery has been found to be altogether unfit for such Cemetery, by reason of the wetness of the soil and the great diffi-5 culties which would have to be overcome in draining the same, and have petitioned to be authorised to sell and dispose of the Land now set apart for the purposes aforesaid, and with the proceeds of such sale to purchase and acquire other land better adapted for use as a public Cemetery; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. The said Municipal Council of the Town of Chatham shall have full Town Council power and authority to sell, grant and convey to any person willing to empowered purchase the same, the fee-simple of the piece or parcel of land now set to sell the apart in the said Town for the purposes of a public Cemetery, for such sum Cemetery. or consideration and on such conditions as they shall deem it advisable to 15 accept; Provided always, that the proceeds of the sale shall be by the said Municipal Council expended in the purchase of other land more suitable for the purposes aforesaid and which the said Municipality shall hold for that purpose; And provided further, that the receipt to be granted by Their receipt the said Council for the purchase money mentioned in any such control to discharge to the purchaser or purchasers or purchasers for the same, and they shall be in no way bound to see to the application, misapplication or non-application of the same or any part thereof.

Il. This Act shall be deemed to be a public Act.
