compensation, is thereby awarded; and the sum thereby awarded as compensation, after deducting the costs of the arbitration, shall be a debt due by the Company to the party or parties entitled to receive such compensation, of which debt the award or copy thereof certified by the Register having the custody thereof, shall be sufficient evidence, and 5 such debt shall bear legal interest from the date of such award until paid.

Directors may appoint agent in or without the Province.

Public Act

V. The Directors of the said Company may appoint such and so many agents in this Province or in any other part of Her Majestys Dominions, as to them shall seem expedient, and may by any By-law to be 10 made for such purpose, empower and authorize any such agent or agents to do and perform any act or thing, or to exercise any powers which the Directors themselves or any of them may lawfully do, perform and exercise, except the power of making By-laws: and all things done by such agent or agents by virtue of powers in him or them vested by any 15 such By-law, shall be as valid and effectual to all intents and purposes as if done by such Directors themselves, any thing in the said Act incorporating the said Company or in any Act amending it, to the contrary notwithstanding.

VI. This Act shall be a Public Act.
