Blood Reserve
5th Dec 1885



Sir

I have the honor to report that since the shooting affray, on this Reserve, which I duly reported early in November, the Indians have been quiet and well behaved.

I am pleased to be able to report, that I feel satisfied we have effectually put down the liquor traffic. About the middle of November an Indian "Pegon" Frank by name, informed me that he could obtain, whiskey from a whiteman, at Lethbridge if he had \$2⁰⁰ dollars, I at once gave him the cash and sent him off, just warning him against drinking any, and to be sure bring me some. about six days after his departure he returned with about 4 oz of detested alcohol: giving me full description of the man from whom he had purchased
