Camp Borden, Ont.	April 25/40		Bell Telephone representatives arrived in Camp with authority to proceed with the reconstruction of telephone system. \$10,000.00 allotted to Air Force Area. 1/3 of cost of switchboard to be borne from above amount.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 26/40		New hangar taken over from Brennan Construction Company and occupied by I.T.S. 3 bush fires in Army Area. Fire risk increasing rapidly; no rain in sight.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 27/40		Two bush fires - Grass very dry. Fire guards around R.C.A.F. Area inspected.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 28/40		Lieutenant Franks from Banting Institute visited Station to try out experimental flying suit.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 29/40		Flying accident involving Harvard Aircraft 1343 during night flying and resulting in death of P.O.(P) G.R. Day. Flares were dropped to locate crash and these started small bush fires which were not serious and were easily put out.	
Camp Borden, Ont.	April 30/40		Funeral party (40 airmen) proceeded to Barrie to accompany body from Smith's Funeral parlour to C.N.R. Station. Flight Lieutenant Dawson was in charge of Funeral party. P/O Ramsay, a personal friend of late P.O.(P) Day accompanied body to Ottawa. Pay parade 13.15 hours.
