Dear Sir, Replying to yours of the 29th. file 144/28-3, we are pleased to quote a rate of \$3940.60 for a Norseman aircraft capable of carrying 1400 pounds per flight including the weight of passengers and the max-imum number of passengers per trip is eight, covering the flying of your number 9 Treaty Trip of 1954 as outlined in the itinerary attached to the above letter.


We would be pleased to furnish a second Norseman aircraft, loading capacity same as above, for your 1954 Treaty Trip number 9 for an additional \$4193.85, however, in this case we would require a firm commitment by May 20, 1954.

We are also pleased to quote a rate of \$1169.00 for a Norseman Aircraft (loading as stated) for the flying of your 1954 Treaty Trip number 5 as outlined.

Regarding the second paragraph of your letter, our minimum charge is two hours at rates applicable in the respective zone wherin the the aircraft is held per day and no additional charge for flying up to this minimum is levied.
