Ottawa, 30th April 1918.

Sir,-

I have to request you to be good enough when you have completed the work at the Blood reserve to survey the recently surrendered portion of the Poor Man's reserve No. 55, containing approximately 5050 acres, consisting of the following sections, - 3, 4, 9, 10, 15, 16, 21, 22, 27, 28, 33 and 34 in Tp. 29, R. 18, W. 2. N. The Dominion Lands System in the adjoining townships is to be projected into the reserve in the usual manner and posted at section and $\frac{1}{4}$ section corners with iron posts similar to those which you have use in the Blood reserve. Another blue print showing these is enclosed; you should have them made at the nearest convenient point.

A blue print copy of the plan of the reserve is enclosed and copies of the plans of the surrounding townships will be obtained and forwarded to you. Should you require any further information than these will give you be good enough to apply for it,

You will be allowed at the same rate of pay as you are now receiving, viz: - \$10.00 per day including Sundays. Mr. Fairchild is to be paid at the rate of \$5.00 per day including Sundays, clear of all expenses.
