Reverend Sir,-

The Department has been informed that the water supply system at the Kamloops Industrial School was practically out of commission, and that a new system would have to be provided in order to meet the requirements of the proposed new school and the outfall which are now in the course of erection.

Would you kindly fill in the enclosed information blank and furnish the Department with a plan of the school grounds showing the location of the building, the position of the source of water supply, the pump, and the proposed location of the reservoir. If possible, the vertical and horizontal distances should be mentioned between each of the above mentioned locations. As soon as this information is received, the Department will prepare plans and specifications and submit same to you in order that the question of a new water supply system may be given further consideration.
