- 1. The significance of the motion the vote of confidence forecast in 1942 not a vote on sonscription but a vote to decide whether this government will stay in office or another government will take its place.
- taken by the government on its responsibility in accordance with the freedom of action given by the plebiscite the decision taken is precisely in accord with the policy announced in 1942, namely, "not necessarily conscription, but conscription if necessary." End the sum of the policy announced in the conscription if necessary."
- The decision on the <u>principle of conscription</u> was taken .
 by Parliament in 1942 in approving Bill 80.
 At the time, it was made clear that there should be no second debate on conscription.
