The Officer Commanding any other unit or detachment in Case Borden may detail two officers to attend the Court-Partial for instruction.

All Officers detailed to attend the Court-Martial for instruction will assemble at said Court Room on said 6th day of September, 1944, at 9 o'clock a.m., (EDST), for the purpose of instruction.

The accused persons will be warned and all witnesses duly required to attend.

The Commanding Officer of each soldier brought before the Court for trial will detail a Court Orderly and Escort for the trial of such soldier.

The Commanding Officer of each soldier brought before the Court for trial will, if the accused requires it, detail an Interpreter for the trial of such soldier.

The proceedings will be forwarded to the A.L. & Q.M.G., Camp Borden, Ontario.
