Overtaking himself now to carry on the work, almost single-handed, for more than a year, he took ill and died; the charge of conducting the work devolved [next] upon the present Editor, who secured assistance from the late Hugh Millar, Prof. Gillespie, Alex. Campbell, Alex. and John Bethune, John Howell, and others. New Tales are promised, which shall equal these.
