Sec. 2.—The Division shall pay only one of the representatives to the Grand Division, a sum sufficient to defray his reasonable expenses incurred while attending the Grand Division. Any brother accepting the nomination of a paid representative and being duly elected, neglecting to attend the regular meetings of the said Grand Division, shall be fined two dollars, unless a satisfactory reason can be given.

Sec. 3.—No part of these By-Laws can be repealed, annulled or altered, unless a proposal in writing be presented to the Division at least one regular meeting previous to the discussion, such alteration shall be decided by a two-third vote. But a By-Law may be suspended for one meeting by the same vote.

Sec. 4.—Lady Visitors may be admitted to this Division, in accordance with the Rules prescribed by the National Division.

Sec. 5.—The W. P. may appoint two brothers to visit a sick brother in case of necessity.
