An ACT for applying certain Monies therein mentioned, for the fervice of the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty-four; and for appropriating such part of the Supplies, granted in this Session of the General Assembly, as are not already appropriated by the Laws or Acts of the Province.

May it please Your Excellency,

E. His Majesty's dutiful and loyal Subjects, the House of Assembly of His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, towards appropriating the Supplies granted to His Majesty in this Session of the General Assembly, and for supplying the Exigencies of His Majesty's Government, do humbly beseech that it may be succeed, and

I. BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Affembly, That, by or out of fuch Monies as now are, or from the to time shall be and remain, in the Public Treafury of this Province, there shall be paid:—

The sum of 2001, to the Speaker of the House of Assembly, for his services during the 2001. Speaker present Session.

And a further sum of 1001, to the Solicitor General, for his services for the present 1001. Solicitor year.

And a further sum of 500l. to the Treasurer of the Province, for his Salary, and as 500l. Treasurer Comptroller and Auditor of Public Accounts, and in lieu of Office Rent, Clerks and all other Contingent Expenses, for the present year.

And a further sum of 1161. 135. 4d. to Nathaniel Atcheson, Esq. the Agent of the 1161. 13s. 4d. Province, for his services for the present year.

And a further sum of 100l. to the Clerk of the Council in General Assembly, and as 100l. Glerk of Clerk to His Majesty's Council, for his services for the same year.

And a further sum of 30l. for defraying the Expenses of the Council in General As- 30l. expenses sembly, for the same year: to be paid on the Certificate of the President of the Coun- of Council cil, and not otherwise.
