boats, managed by men quite unprepared for action, their arms and ammunition generally wet, from the nature of their work? Will continual and numerous efcorts, marching on the banks of the river, be proposed an expedient? The multitude of troops and prodigious expence this would require, would render it intolerable; befides the chain of forts which would be neceffary for this end, would never be fuffered by the Six Nations (who are the proprietors of the country through which this communication is carried) whilft they are an independent people; and independent they are, as long as there are two different European powers in America; that is to fay, as long as they can be fupplied with ammunition by one to act against the other. Was there only one power then they would be
