


COLLEGE EXTENSION LECTURES. PRELIMINARY NOTICE. Courses of lectures covering the requirements of the Licentiate in Arts of the Council of Higher Education and of the Second or Sophomore year in certain Canadian Universities will be organized for the next Academic year beginning October 1st, 1916, and ending April 30th, 1917.
