

HUGHES STATES LONDON'S CAMP GOES TO GUELPH

Minister of Militia Had Assured London Soldiers Would Stay.

RELIED UPON HIS WORD

Civic Authorities Do Not Believe Hope Need Be Abandoned.

Word was received from the Department of Militia and Defence yesterday that the summer training camp for active service would be held in Guelph and that all troops now in London would be transferred, together with the divisional headquarters.

In view of the strategic location of London and the fact that the civic authorities have been willing to meet the department's every suggestion, the announcement came as a bomb shell. It was conveyed by The Advertiser, both through Ottawa and by reason of official information received in this city.

Hughes' Swift Turnover.

As interpreted by those in a position to speak with authority, the latest decision of Gen. The Hon. Sam Hughes means that every soldier now training in this city will be moved to and kept in Guelph during that period when the weather will permit of outside camping. Less than two weeks ago Gen. Hughes assured Major H. A. Stevenson and Controller J. Moore that London would not only retain the men of the present units, but would have a larger force.

Tuesday, it was officially announced from Ottawa that London was to be a concentration camp for the summer and recruiting would be resumed within a short time.

London Not Inactive.

While citizens generally are agitated in the matter, London is not standing still, and Gen. Hughes will be communicated with at once, and if such a thing is possible, an explanation will be received. There are said to be good prospects that London will not lose the camp, although The Advertiser correspondent at Guelph wired in the dispatch which which the city had already already making preparations. Further than this, the divisional headquarters in this city have been instructed to send engineers to Guelph to prepare the ground.

Incidentally, the correspondent tells that John M. Taylor, a prominent Conservative of Guelph, and close personal friend of Gen. Hughes, had much to do with the decision. Mr. Taylor, who has been mentioned for Conservative honors, had been mentioned for one to see the chief of the soldiers and the maker of camps, and after that visit an announcement was made.

William Gray Dumfries.

The Advertiser, which recently suggested with some vigor the necessity for action on the part of those who have been in the matter, called William Gray, M. P. for London, who has been dealing with the military authorities in the matter, and Mayor H. A. Stevenson, who has the unequalled promise of Gen. Hughes that London would continue to be the chief centre for troop concentration in Western Ontario.

Will Attempt to Keep Camp.

The general opinion is that London would do everything in its power to retain the soldiers and secure the camp as it was announced. London has been willing to make any concessions that the authorities might ask, and business
