

G. T. P. AGAINST COST OF EAST DIVISION

Contract Binding the Private Company to Take Over Eastern Division May Prove White Elephant

Ottawa, July 9.—Difficulties are accumulating for the National Transcontinental Railway project. On the same day this week two versions of a very serious nature occurred. First, the chief engineer of the line, Mr. Hugh D. Lumden, resigned his position in the G. T. P. and is due to trouble on the district immediately east of Winnipeg, and the government press already is attacking Mr. Lumden and stating it is interested that his office lies in having agreed with the engineers of the Grand Trunk Pacific that the line has been built in the most extravagant fashion. Secondly, it was announced that the three engineers, Mr. Fitzmaurice, Mr. Vauterlin and Mr. Modjeski, who have been appointed a commission to manage the erection of the Quebec bridge, cannot agree on three very important points in regard to the work, and have found it necessary to call in two other engineers for consultation. One of the points is somewhat technical, and concerns one with regard to the length of span and the stresses; the second was on the matter of whether the masonry piers are massive enough; and the third was on the still more elementary point as to whether the site, which has been chosen, is the most advantageous one. If the consultation results in the site being condemned, all the time heretofore spent on the business will have been wasted and it will be years before the structure is completed. Last season Mr. Borden directed the completion of the bridge in 1916 and none of the ministers ventured to contradict him. This later development may postpone the finishing of the work to a still later date.

Hodgins Charges Recalled.

Mr. Lumden's resignation will at once be charged to the fact that it is in a sense a development. It will be remembered that in 1908, Major Hodgins, an experienced engineer, a Liberal, who has been in this same district, extending from Winnipeg to Superior Junction, made charges against the G. T. P. of over-classification on his division. His charges presented two aspects: He charged that over-classification was prevailing, and he charged that various persons, including the premier and members of the commission, were converting the classification. An investigation was held by the House of Commons, and was turned by the majority of the committee into an investigation of the subject. After a great deal of brow-beating and worrying Mr. Hodgins, who had his assertion as to conviction and the committee by a party vote decided that all his charges were disproven. The result was that Mr. Hodgins was over-classified, and consequent decrease in the government, escaped satisfactory investigation. During the investigation, however, the correspondence produced disclosed the fact that the Grand Trunk Pacific engineers, in making their classification against the excessive cost of the line, had been charging over-classification in many places. Mr. Hodgins, the G. T. P. of course is directly interested in the cost of the road because the contract binds it to the National Transcontinental, and the Eastern Division, when it is completed and to pay 3 per cent. interest on the cost of the road. Owing to a consideration which will appear later the cost of this particular division of the line is of special interest to the railway company. Not long ago the division was advanced to a point of completion which was not in fact completed. The authoritative estimate of the cost, and a board of arbitration comprising Mr. Colquhoun, Mr. Keiller, chief engineer of the company, and Mr. Lumden, chief engineer of the G. T. P., went over the ground and examined the line.

Extraneous Alarms G. T. P.

Dual Disturbing Factors.

Thus we have two disturbing factors in the problem of the Quebec bridge project in a state of confusion which may postpone the completion of the work and so leave the eastern end of the G. T. P. minus a most important link. There is serious trouble over the cost of the western section of the line. The Quebec bridge difficulty is this: The government has built the line from Lewis to Moncton; this is nearly completed; it will cost from \$30,000,000 to \$35,000,000; and it is hopelessly cut off for several years, and perhaps more, from the rest of the line. SITUATION IS NOT SO SERIOUS

Soldiers are in Control at Cape Breton Where Big Strike is on Among the Colliers

Sydney, N.S., July 10.—Five hundred soldiers of the Royal Canadian Regiment, Halifax, are patrolling the collieries of the Dominion Coal Company, and the scenes of violence enacted during the first three days have been reduced to a minimum. The fourth day of the strike opened under conditions which were not materially different from those which prevailed. Both parties are strenuously anxious to make it appear that things are going in their favor. Reports from number six were panicky yesterday, and the news went out that the colliery was being broken down with stones, a portion of the fence torn down, the electric light bulbs strung along the fence wires were broken or rather were shot off by shotguns. About 12:30 last night when the violent storm of wind and rain that was raging was at its height, the screams of the siren fire whistle threw many of the residents of Glace Bay into a panic. The siren was fired, aroused from sleep, rushed onto the street to inquire the cause of the shouting, and many of them, with a few that did disaster was stalking abroad. PLANT OF PROOF

Dublin, July 10.—Keen interest is being taken in the observations made by the Chancellor of the Exchequer in answer to the case put before him on Monday last on behalf of the Irish landholders. What he said there will be remains doubtful. Mr. Lloyd-George recognized two circumstances which call for special consideration in the case of Ireland—first, that there is not in the English sense of the term a marketable value in the number of public houses and the diminution of the population, and second, that 80 per cent. of the public houses are concerned in a mixed trade, which is an important element where payment is made upon the ground. The Chancellor of the Exchequer admitted that these special considerations called for special consideration, and he stated that some concession would ultimately be made. In the English trade opinion is divided as to whether the whole bill more fairly or less fairly regarded outside of Ireland. That the friendly attitude of the Chancellor of the Exchequer, who is in the position of a mediator, is a considerable factor in the present form its fate is almost certain.
