Our "New Brunswick Nurseries."

It is not many years since our
Province could claim to have any
nurseries of any extent for the culti-
vation of the different varieties of
fruit trees. Within the past twenty
years, our people have paid hundreds
of thousands of dollars to the United
States nurseries for apple trees and
small fruits, and there is little in
the country now to show for the ex-
penditure, the large majority of the
trees have died; some varieties from
want of being acclimated, others from
want of proper care and attention.
As a rule they are not suited to the
climate, and consequently die or be-
come so diseased as to be of little
value. Of late years, however, there
has been a change for the better.

The Percheron Horse.
Considerable interest is now being
manifested in the Percheron-Norman
breed of horses, occasioned no doubt
by the fact that there are some three
or four stallions of this breed in the
Province. These were imported by
the Government some three years
ago, and sold to the Agricultural
Societies. Carleton, Sunbury and
St. John being the respective pur-
chasers. The Sussex and Stoddard
Agricultural Societies also imported a
horse of this breed, Messrs.
Thos. Roach and Fairweather making
the selection for the Society. All
these horses were imported direct
from France
