

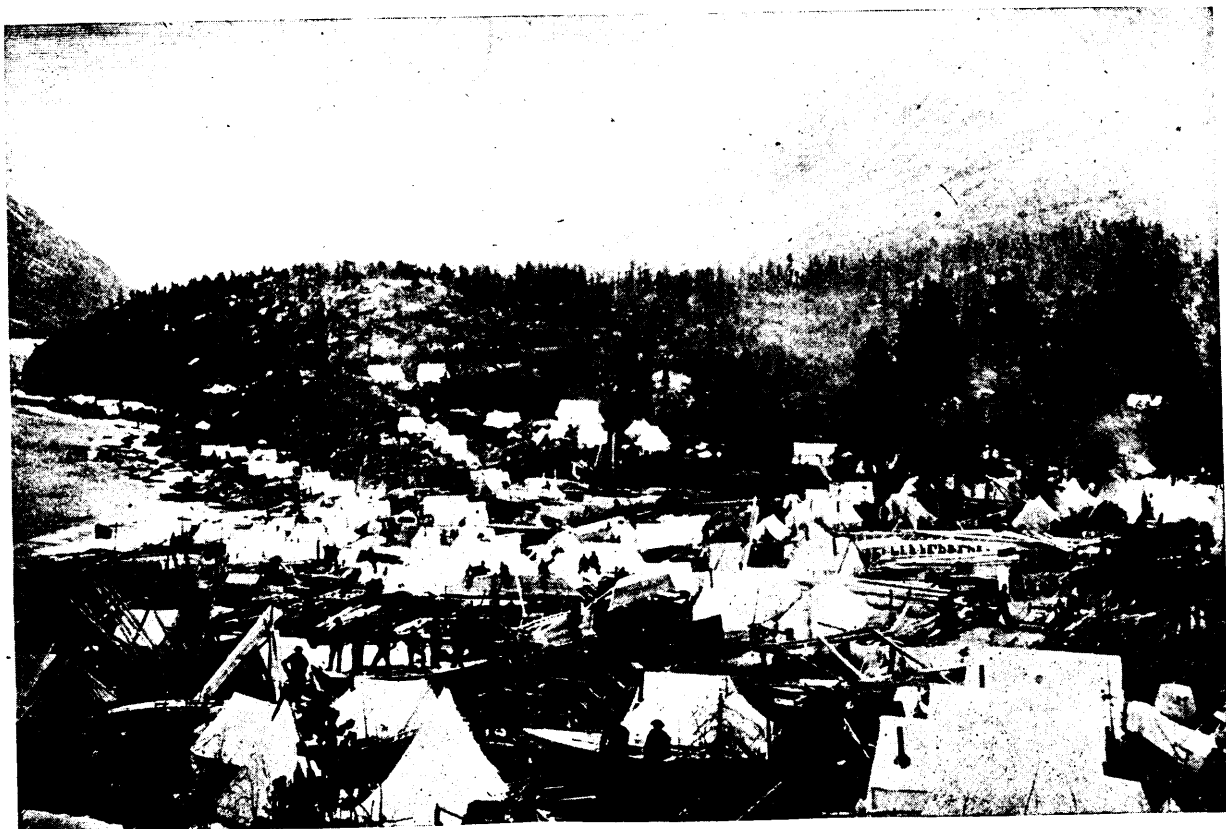

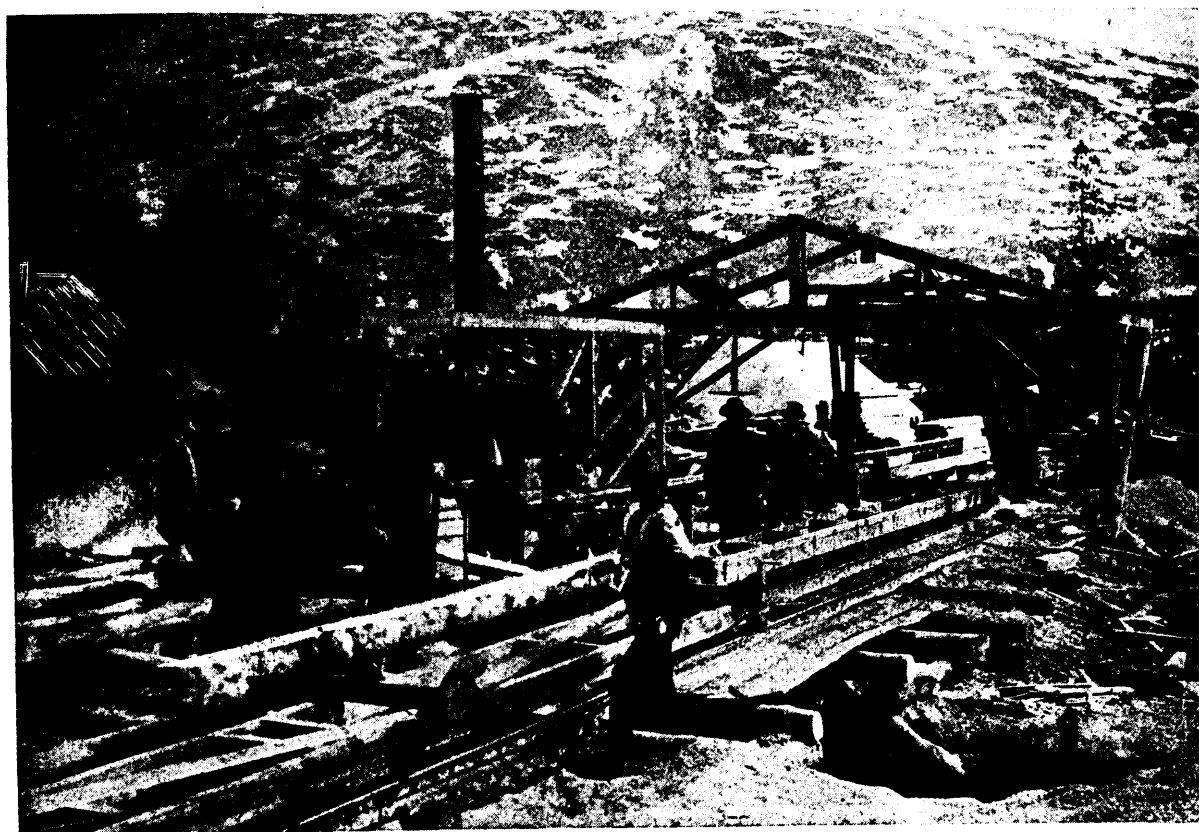
THE BOAT BUILDERS CAMP AT BENNETT.
