For sevral yiarz it apiard gud tu yuz k definitli hwen it stopt eni strong silabl (ðat iz, immidiatli folod ðe vael 1ðerin). Conversli, hwen yu hav k in ðat pozision, ðe silabl iz strong and stopt. In 1ðer werdz, k iz strong c. In "ecspekt" ðe sekond silabl haz strong stres; in "sicses" ðe ferst mist bi wk-er, els it wud hav k in sted ov c—a help in promnsiesion. Stil 1ðer eczamplz ar: sispekt, condickt (naun), condikt (verb), hikip, inflikt, respektivli, tabako, mokassin, moroko, aksis, aksez, aktiv, fricwent, cwat, ini kwiti, apoplektic, tecnik, yunik.

If yu ar a helper bi a gud wîn, a tu-hand lender. Tek hold ov hwot pruvz tu mich for an 1ðer and lift hartili. Yur gud chiar and sinsiar efort wil inspiaiar him wið a neu strength and carej, and hi wil bi faund ebl tu du moar 1ðan befoar yu tuk hold. De old lainz abaut grasping netlz laitli and geting sting, hwail ðe ferm hand faindz 1ðem silk, holdz hiar. Haf-harted,

wîn-handed efort taiarz yu and helps bit litl, tu handz wilingli lentmek lait werk and moar 1ðan dîbl ðe efisiensi in both helper and helpt.—*Onward*, 24th O'g., 1912.

Strenjerz me not understand, rven Sînz ov ðe Blid disregard; yet, werld araund and jenesionz thru, it persists, chrf gloari ov aur nesionz, abaiding bond ov aur pipl.

Tu bring internasional fraterniti wi nd a neu nasional aidral, a neu nasional spirit, a neu motev: ðat ov Jîzus hwen hi sed 'lf eni wud bi gret amingst yu, let him serv.' Despait blster and jingoizm, nesionz ov ðe Anglo-Sakson yuniti fes ðat standard and ar truer tu it tude 1ðan ever, moar obidient tu fundamentalz ov Cristian internasionalizm.—Dr J. A.
