He was not discouraged, and started a second collection soon after, his special favorite being the stamps of the United States, Canada, France, and Chile. He has been a small dealer for some time, but especially active for two years past. He deals principally in Canadian stamps.

Mr. Magill has written for nearly a dozen journals in all,
