

Colts and sickness are frequently produced by washing bedrooms during the winter. In cold and damp weather purchase a quart of common sand, make it very wel, and sweep it with a stiff brush all over the room. The sand may be used for months by washing it.

FRECKLE LOTION.—Muriale ammonia, one dram; cologne water, two drams; distilled water, seven ounces; mix and use as a

BAKED CHOCOLATE CUSTARD.—Scald a quart of milk, atir in four heaping table-spoonfuls of grated chocolate, and aimmer two minutes to dissolve it. Beat up the yolks of six eggs with one cup of sugar and add to the milk and chocolate. Silr for a minute, then add vanilla flavouring and pour into dish.

CARRAGE.—Like most green vegetable, cabbage contains only one-tenth of its weigh; in solid substance, the other nine-tenths being water. It consists chiefly of albumenoid substance, with no fat or oil, and very little starch; consequently, cabbage should be eaten with fat substances, as dripping, or bacon, to supply the deficiencies.

GENUINE SCOTCH OATMEAL CAKES.—
Ingredients: oatmeal, water and salt. Mix very stiff into oblong cakes one-eighth inch in thickness, and lake on boards before an open fire. By the addition of one or two eggs and substituting milk for the water, these cakes can be made more appetizing; but this is, of course, a departure from the original recipe.

CLEANING COMPOUNDS.—Mix one ounce of borax and once ounce of gum camphor with one quart of boiling water. When cool, add one pint of alcohol; bottle and cork tightly. When wanted for use, shake well and sponge the garments to be cleaned. This is an excellent mixture for cleaning soiled black cashmere and woollen dresses, coat collars and black felt hats.

For adults, a box of compound thubarb pills, calomel pills, seidlitz powders, blue pills, spirits of hartshorn, spirits of lavender, sal volat le, quinine, tincture of rhubarb, ether, some lint, and old linen, should alwayz be kept ready to hand. The quantities must depend upon the number in family, but a few ounces of salts and senna are sufficient, because they can be readily obtained.—From the Children's Dressmaker.

Cure for a Felon.—I believe it is better to scatter a felon, thereby saving pain and trouble. The following prescription I had from an old lady, with the affirmation that in the course of a long-life she had never known it to fail if applied in season, and I can add the same, having had an opportunity to test it several times in my own family—the last time, only the past week, and with complete success. The first time I tried it the felon had been in progress several days, and became very painful, with red streaks running up the arm, while in the armpit the glands were swollen, forming what is commonly known as kernels; but after two days' application of the plaster, the swelling and pain ceased, and the felon was 'no more.' Take equal parts of lard soap, salt and spirits of turpentine. Shave the soap and mix with the other ingredients, and apply as a plaster. Some use kerosene, where turpentine is not at hand, but I prefer the turpentine. If the skin is thick it is well, to soak in hot lye before applying the plaster. soak in hot lye before applying the plaster.
