The Government of Canada  
and the Government of the French Republic,  
hereinafter called "the Parties",

Considering their Cultural Agreement, signed  
November 17, 1965, and their Exchange of Letters regarding  
scientific co-operation of October 23, 1973,

Resolved to encourage the development of their  
co-operation and exchanges in the museums field,

Have agreed as follows:

#### Article I

The Parties shall develop their co-operation  
and exchanges in the museums field.

#### Article II

1. Without prejudice to actions concerning exhibitions<sup>s</sup>  
carried out pursuant to Article V of the Cultural Agreement  
of November 17, 1965, the Parties shall develop their  
co-operation and exchanges in all fields of museum  
activity, including conservation, restoration, training,  
research, archaeology, information, inventories and  
the production of audiovisual documents.

2. The terms and conditions of this co-operation  
may be set out in administrative arrangements between  
the relevant administrations of the two Parties.
