PRAYERS.

The following Bills, from the Senate, were severally read the first time, and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House, viz:—

Bill No. 8 (Letter B of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to amend the Exchequer Court Act".—Mr. Garson.

Bill No. 9 (Letter C of the Senate), intituled: "An Act to amend the Department of Justice Act".—Mr. Garson.

The following Questions on the Order Paper were passed by the House as Orders for Return, under subsection 4 of Standing Order 44, and Orders of the House were issued to the proper officers accordingly, viz:—

By Mr. Shaw:—1. In 1948, how many individuals in Alberta were employed or authorized by the Department of Transport or any other Department of Government or any official thereof to engage in house to house canvassing in connection with the checking and/or sale of radio receiving set licences?

2. What were the names and addresses of all such persons?

3. What salaries, commissions, expenses and/or other payments were made to each canvasser?

By Mr. MacInnis:—1. How many of the Corps of Commissionnaires are employed at the Shaughnessy Hospital, Vancouver?

2. What is the monthly salary of each such employee?
3. When did the existing salary rate come into effect?
