A PROCLAMATION

KNOW YE, that We being desirous and resolved, as soon as may be, to meet
Our People of Canada, and to have their advice in Parliament, do hereby,
by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, summon and call
together the House of Commons in and for Canada, to meet at Our CITY OF
OTTAWA, on the fifth day of May next, then and there to have conference and
treaty with the Great Men and Senate of Canada.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and
the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: The
Honourable PATRICK KERWIN, Chief Justice of Canada and Deputy of
Our Right Trusty and Well-beloved Counsellor, VINCENT MASSEY,
Member of Our Order of the Companions of Honour, Governor General
and Commander-in-Chief of Canada.

AT OTTAWA, this first day of February in the year of Our Lord one thousand
nine hundred and fifty-eight and in the sixth year of Our Reign.
