AMENDED STANDING ORDER 65

Special committees.

(1) No special committee may, without leave of the House, consist of more than fifteen Members; such leave shall not be moved for without notice; and in the case of Members proposed to be added, after the first appointment of the committee, a new notice shall be given including the names of the Members proposed to be added.

Quorum.

(2) A majority of the Members of a special committee shall be a quorum unless the House has otherwise ordered

AMENDED STANDING ORDER 69

Introduction. (1) Every bill is introduced upon motion for leave specifying the title of the bill; or upon motion to appoint a committee to prepare and bring it in.

Explanation of provisions. (2) A motion for leave to introduce a bill shall be decided without debate or amendment, provided that any Member moving for such leave may be permitted to give a succincular explanation of the provisions of the said bill.
