Enquiry by the Hon. Mr. *Tessier* :

- Nov. 18.—1. Whether a Bill in reference to the Intercolonial Railway will be introduced during this first part of the Session?
2. Whether the selection of the *route* for the Intercolonial Railway will be left to the decision of the Parliament of *Canada*, or only of the Executive Government of *Canada*, subject in either case to the approval of one of Her Majesty's principal Secretaries of State?
