cable your Petitioners are of opinion that it is desirable that Parliament should pass some general measure, applicable at once to the whole country, capable of being effectually enforced, and putting an end to the use of ardent spirits as a beverage, which is believed to be the real root of the evil.

They are also of opinion that the interest of temperance and public health would be promoted by a Government inspection of all liquors in order to prevent the possibility of noxious adulteration.

Your Petitioners therefore pray that no legislation may take place this year, and that a general Act may be passed embodying the views of your petitioners.

And your Petitioners will ever pray.
