

Including timbering, laying track, handling coal, brattice, building, dirt to be picked and left in the gob.

To be paid at the rate of \$11.52 per lineal yard. Breasts of greater or smaller dimensions, to be paid in full proportion.

BREASTS (Up the pitch angle): As per present practice, per cubic yard, 50 cents.

PILLARS:

Including timbering from across the pitch work, 50 cents per cubic yard.

Including timbering from up the pitch work, 43 cents per cubic yard.

South Mine.

No. 1 Seam.

GANGWAY: 7ft. 4 inch collars between notches, 8ft. legs, 11 ft. spread, 7 feet high from rail, including laying of track, digging ditch, timbering, lagging and rock work, \$12.00.

COUNTER GANGWAY: 6 feet by 6 feet or thickness of seam, per lineal yard \$3.50.

CHUTES: 6 feet by 6 feet or thickness of seam, per lineal yard, \$3.00.

ANGLE CHUTES AND CROSS ANGLES: 14 feet by thickness of seam, \$4.15. Wider or narrower angles to be paid in proportion down to 12 feet.

PILLARS: Including timbering, per cubic yard, 45 cents.

DAVENPORT COAL COMPANY.

No. 2 Seam.

GANGWAY (10 feet wide by 7 feet high): \$10.00 per lineal yard, including loading and mining coal and rock, setting posts with lagging on the high side, and laying track.
