

these meetings no other business than the special business for which they are called shall be transacted.

3. Sections of the Club may be formed for the discussion of special subjects, *e.g.*, Political Science and History, English Literature, Mathematics and Physics, Astronomy, Natural Science, etc.

4. It shall be the duty of such sections to make a full report of their proceedings at the Annual Meeting of the Club.

5. Such special sections may elect to full membership of their sections individuals who are interested in the work in which they are engaged, but who are not Graduates or Undergraduates of the University of Toronto.

6. The annual fee shall be fifty cents.

7. The order of business at meetings of the Club shall be as follows :—

- (a) Reading of the minutes.
- (b) Recommendations and reports.
- (c) Elections.
- (d) Miscellaneous business.
- (e) Presentation and discussion of papers previously announced.
- (f) Any other scientific communications.

8. At any regular meeting the order of business may be changed by a majority vote of the members present.
