THIS SQUARE OCCUPIES THE SITE  
OF "LA CITADELLE" BUILT IN 1685,  
REPLACING THE MILL ERECTED BY  
MAISONNEUVE AND D'AILLEBOUST IN 1660.  
ROYAL BATTERY 1723. LEVELLED  
AND PRESENTED TO THE CITY BY EARL  
DALHOUSIE, GOVERNOR-GENERAL, 1821  
NEAR THE EAST CORNER OF NOTRE DAME  
STREET STOOD THE PORTE ST-MARTIN  
(QUEBEC GATE). ETHAN ALLAN  
ENTERED IT PRISONER OF WAR, 1775.  
THIS STATION REPLACED THE FRENCH  
ARSENAL REMOVED 1881, WITH THE LAST  
PORTION OF THE FORTIFICATION  
WALLS IN 1721.
