

custody as stores, for the information of the Committee of Management.

IV. He shall purchase, under the direction of the Committee of Management, provisions and all other stores for the use of the Hospital, except medicines.

V. He shall keep under his key all wines, spirits, sugar, molasses, unmade linen, blanketing, and all other stores and necessaries.

VI. He shall keep in a book provided for that purpose a regular account of all monies received and disbursed by him on behalf of the Hospital.

VII. He shall enter in a book to be kept for that purpose an account of all money, clothes, or other articles belonging to any patients who may wish to deposit the same in his charge, and he shall return all such deposits to them when discharged, or, in case of death, to their representatives.

VIII. He shall not employ any patient without the sanction of the Physician or Surgeon, under whose care such patient is placed.

IX. He shall have the power, under the direction of the Committee of Management, to hire and dismiss all the nurses and servants employed in or about the Hospital; and should any of these employed be guilty of profane swearing, drunkenness, bringing spirituous liquors clandestinely into the house, or other gross misconduct, he shall promptly, with the concurrence of the House Surgeon, dismiss them, and report the matter to the Committee of Management.

X. He shall take particular care that no wine or spirits are used in the Hospital, except by the directions of the Physicians or Surgeons for the use of the patients.
